


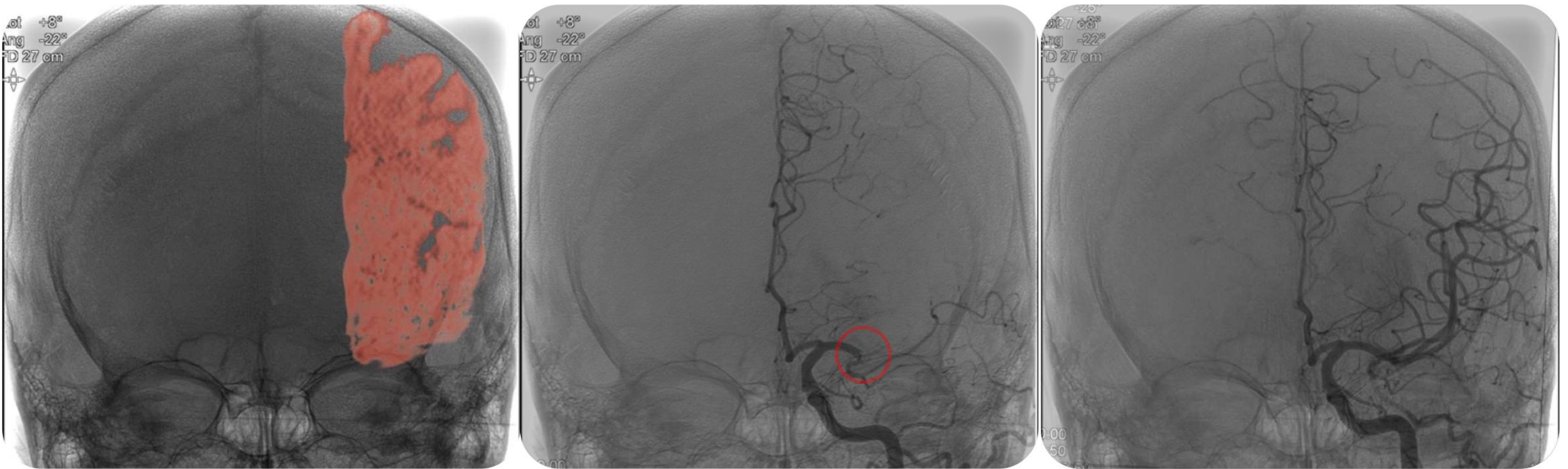

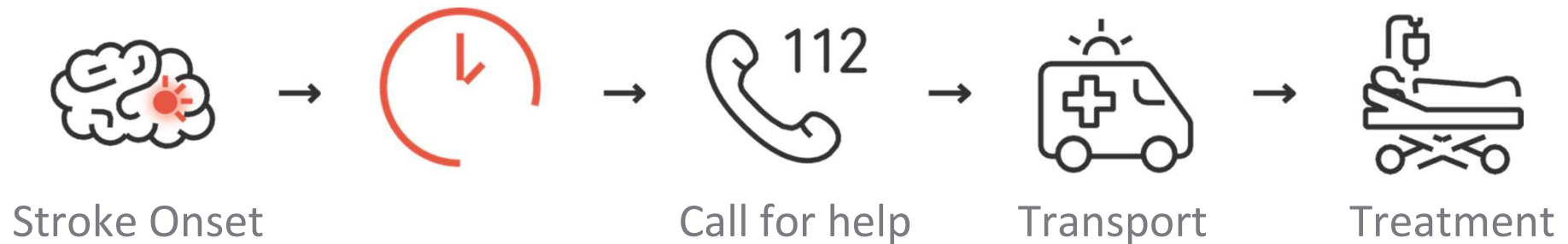
Stroke is the leading cause of disability

The Basic Principles of Stroke Alarm

83-90% of stroke patients suffer arm paresis ¹



Large patient groups will benefit

The risk for a stroke is especially high for certain patients

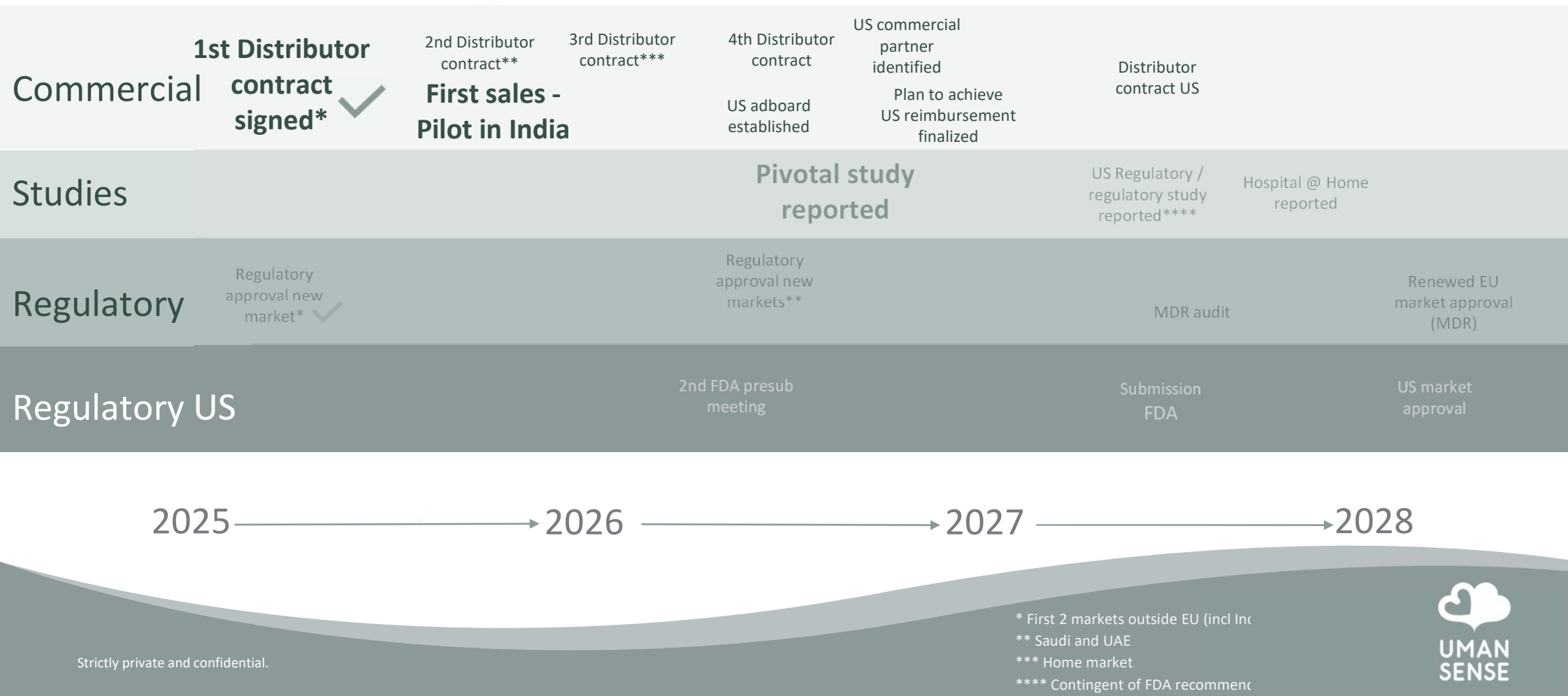

Clinical Development

- 500 patient EFFECT study final report

Commercial Development

- Commercial sales in India, Saudi and selected EU countries
- US market entry process (Ad-board, prepare market access to enable partner contract)

Regulatory

- US regulatory study (US citizens + EFFECT) & FDA
- MDR preparations (EU)

Manufacturing

- Scale-up

Will provide runway for commercial sales in several markets and preparation for US market entry

Uman Sense is already a commercial company

Stroke Alarm has market approval

- Stroke Alarm is CE-marked
- Regulatory approval Saudi – planned March 2026

The first sales will be booked 2025

- 1st distributor agreement – Q1 2025
- 2nd distributor agreement – to be signed Q4 2025

Traction 2025

- Strong support from international scientific community for Stroke Alarm concept
- Direct request from Swedish patients to purchase Stroke Alarm outside the EFFECT study
- EU Horizon grant (Karolinska, Århus, Erasmus) for Hospital@Home
- Research grant from Medtronic
